TIPS ON HOW TO KEEP YOUR HOME SAFE:

- **Keep all windows locked, regardless of the level they're on**
- **If you have a window AC unit that can't be removed in the winter, make sure it is bolted in to the wall**
- **Keep doors locked ... use a deadbolt if possible.**
- **Never keep objects close to windows that are easy to climb on (i.e. garbage pails, ladders, outdoor furniture)**
- **Improve the security of your home (invest in an alarm system and exterior cameras)**
- **Keep the interior and exterior of your home well lit**
- **Keep trees and shrubs pruned to prevent a burglar from hiding**
- **Identify any potential points of vulnerability and correct those weaknesses**
- **If you see something, say something.. Call 911 or 973-680-4141 with any suspicious activity**
